

12-core direct-buried optical cable splicing



Article Overview

Splicing 12-core direct-buried optical cables requires high-quality fusion splicing, proper splice closures, adherence to bend radius limits, and compliance with industry standards such as ITU-T L.101 and FOA installation guidelines.

Cable Preparation and Handling

Before splicing, ensure the cable is handled carefully to avoid mechanical stress or damage. Protective materials on the cable should remain in place until installation, and sharp bends or twists must be avoided. Use figure-8 loops when laying cable on the ground to prevent twisting, and maintain a minimum bend radius of 20 times the cable diameter under tension or 10 times without tension. For direct-buried cables, inspect the installation area for sharp rocks or objects that could damage the sheath.

Splicing Procedures

- Fusion splicing is the preferred method for outdoor and buried fiber cables, as it ensures low-loss, high-reliability connections.
- Use factory-made pigtails for termination, which are fusion spliced to the cable ends.
- Follow the fiber manufacturer's recommendations for stripping, cleaving, and splicing to maintain optical performance.
- Ensure splice closures are rated for direct-buried applications, resistant to corrosion, and capable of withstanding environmental extremes. Closures should ac...
