Doors may include electronic clasp locks for security, and options such as sliding or swinging doors are available to accommodate cabinet-to-cabinet or cabinet-to-wall configurations . Proper door sealing is critical to prevent bypass airflow and maintain cooling efficiency. 3. Cable Management Components Cable troughs or M-shaped binding plates are installed on top of cabinets to route signal and power cables separately, ensuring electrical safety and minimizing airflow obstruction . These troughs are modular, assembled from side panels, pallets, and baffles to separate different cable types and maintain organized pathways. 4. Aisle Containment Panels Containment panels or strips create a physical barrier between cold supply air and hot exhaust air, forming the cold aisle enclosure . Panels are modular and can be in...
