Aramid Strength Members Aramid yarns, commonly known as Kevlar®, are embedded within the cable to provide tensile strength. They protect the fiber from breaking during pulling, bending, or installation, ensuring durability and reliability in real-world handling . 4. Jacket The outer jacket encases all internal components, holding the fiber and strength members together. Jackets are made from materials like PVC or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) and can be customized in color or markings to meet project standards and environmental requirements . 5. Connectors Connectors terminate the ends of the patch cord, ensuring precise optical alignment for minimal signal loss. Common connector types include LC, SC, FC, and MTP, each suited for different network applications. Connector assembly involves cl...
