Baseband boards typically do not directly host optical modules but can interface with them through dedicated backplane or host connectors compatible with SFP, SFP+, QSFP, or similar transceivers.

Overview

Baseband boards, such as the RNS805-RU-BB, are primarily designed for processing 4G/5G radio signals and interfacing with RF front-end modules, supporting Cat A Split 7.2 O-RU configurations and operating in TDD or FDD modes from 600 MHz to 6 GHz (RANsemi) . Similarly, BBUs like the BBU5900 and ZTE BBU series provide multi-mode 2G/3G/4G/5G support with flexible networking and high-performance board slots . These boards focus on baseband signal processing rather than direct optical transceiver integration.

Optical Module Interfaces

Pluggable optical modules, including SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP28, QSFP-DD, XFP, and CFP, are designed for high-speed data transmission over fiber and are typically connected via dedicated host interfaces or backplanes . These modules are hot-pluggable and support various data rates (1G, 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G) depending on the module type. Baseband boards themselves usually do not have native SFP or QSFP cages but can connect to optical modules through:...
