

Cable sealing in cable trays



Article Overview

Cables in cable trays can be effectively sealed using firestop systems, modular sealing plugs, GRP sealants, and compressible tray inlays to ensure fire safety, weatherproofing, and maintainability.

Firestop and Penetration Sealing

For cable trays passing through walls, floors, or slabs, firestopping is essential to prevent the spread of fire and smoke. Openings should be tightly sealed using fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool, ensuring no visible cracks or voids remain. Large openings may require a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing, and gaps around cables should be minimal, typically not exceeding 1 cm², with packing thickness of at least 24 cm for effective protection. Cover plates should be square, consistent, and painted evenly to maintain integrity and aesthetics .

Modular and Replaceable Sealing Systems

Modern solutions include modular sealing systems that allow easy installation and future cable additions. For example, a tray inlay with a replaceable cover can seal cables while leaving space for new cables to be added without removing the entire seal. Compressible seal portions in the inlay and cover enclose the cables securely, providing both fire and smoke protection while maintaining flexibility for maintenance or expansion .
