

Cable tray distribution box wiring requirements



Article Overview

Cable tray wiring should be routed from the distribution box using NEC-compliant methods, ensuring proper grounding, support, and separation of cables.

Routing and Connection

Cables from the distribution box should be installed in the cable tray in a way that maintains mechanical support and electrical continuity. All conductors must be secured at intervals according to the tray manufacturer's instructions, and non-horizontal runs should be fastened to transverse members to prevent stress on the cables . Supports must be provided where cables enter raceways from the tray to avoid strain and potential damage .

Grounding and Bonding

For metallic cable trays, grounding and bonding are mandatory. The tray must be electrically continuous, with all splice points properly bonded, and connected to the building's grounding system . If mechanical connections do not ensure continuity, bonding jumpers should be used. This prevents shock hazards, equipment failure, and ensures compliance with NEC requirements .
