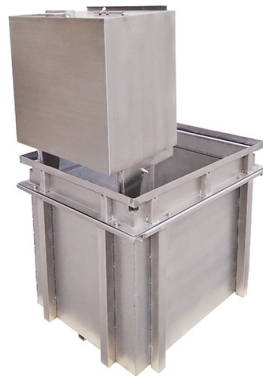


Cable tray ground wire connection copper plate



Article Overview

A copper plate can be used to bond a cable tray to the ground by providing a secure, low-resistance connection between the tray and the equipment grounding conductor (EGC).

Purpose of Grounding Cable Trays

Grounding a cable tray ensures that any stray electrical currents are safely directed to the earth, preventing electric shocks, equipment damage, or fire hazards. The cable tray itself can serve as an EGC if it meets NEC requirements, but a separate grounding conductor is often used for added safety and reliability .

Using a Copper Plate for Grounding

A copper plate acts as a bonding interface between the cable tray and the grounding system. The plate provides a large contact area, ensuring a low-resistance path for fault currents. Key points include:

- **Material Compatibility:** Use copper or tin/zinc-plated connectors when bonding to aluminum trays to prevent electrolytic corrosion .
- **Connection Method:** The copper plate is typically bolted or clamped to the tray at splice points or sections where grounding is required. The grounding wire is then attached to the plate using a secure mechanical connection, such as a bolt or grounding clamp
