 - **Perforated Trays:** Flat-bottom trays with holes for ventilation and drainage, suitable for medium loads .
 - **Solid-Bottom Trays:** Provide maximum protection from dust and moisture; consider heat dissipation .
 - **Wire Mesh/Basket Trays:** Lightweight, flexible, and suitable for data or low-voltage cables .
 - **Channel Trays:** Closed channels for sensitive or small cable runs .
- Support and Spacing:** Proper support prevents sagging and cable damage. Mount trays to floors, walls, ceilings, or cabinet tops using brackets or J-bolt kits. Maintain recommended support intervals based on tray load and span . **Cable Separation and Grouping:** Separate power and data cables to prevent electromagnetic interference. Group cables logically to simplify maintenance and future expansion . **Bend Radius and Siz...**
