Yes, cable trays can be placed on the ground, provided they remain accessible, properly grounded, and comply with NEC installation standards.

Ground-Level Installation

Cable trays are versatile and can be installed on floors, elevated supports, or walls, as long as they are accessible for maintenance and inspection and not in prohibited areas such as hoistways or enclosed spaces . Ground placement is common in industrial facilities, data centers, and commercial buildings where overhead installation is impractical .

Grounding and Safety Considerations

For metallic cable trays, grounding is mandatory. The tray itself can serve as an Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) if it meets NEC requirements, including minimum cross-sectional area and proper bonding between sections . Grounding ensures that any fault current is safely directed to earth, reducing the risk of electric shock or equipment damage . Non-metallic trays require separate grounding conductors for safety .

Environmental and Material Considerations

When placing trays on the ground, consider moisture, corrosion, and mechanical damage. Aluminum trays should avoid direct contact with bare copper conductors to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors are recommended in such case...
