Article Overview

Cambodia features a diverse range of bridge structures, from historic stone and wooden bridges to modern suspension and cable-stayed bridges, playing a crucial role in national connectivity and urban development.

Notable Bridges

Cambodia's bridge infrastructure includes both historic and modern structures. Spean Praptos, an ancient stone bridge, exemplifies Khmer engineering heritage, while Kizuna Bridge and the Japanese Friendship Bridge represent modern engineering achievements that support vehicular traffic and regional connectivity . In Phnom Penh, seven major bridges—including the Cambodia-China Friendship Bridge, Prek Pnov, and Russey Keo Suspension Bridge—have reshaped urban mobility and are part of a plan to expand to ten bridges by 2030 across the Tonle Sap, Bassac, and Mekong rivers .

Modern Infrastructure Projects

The China Road and Bridge Corporation (CRBC) has been instrumental in Cambodia's infrastructure development, constructing highways and bridges such as the New Chroy Changvar Bridge and Koh Thom Bridge, while ongoing projects include extensions of Highway 76 and Highway 44 . Additionally, the Mekong River Bridge in Phnom Penh, part of Xi Jinping Boulevard, is under construction to improve connectivity with Kandal province, reflecting Cambodia's focus on modern, large-scale bridge projects
