

Can a distribution box be placed in a fire room

A distribution box can be placed in a fire-rated room if proper fire safety measures, clearances, and code-compliant firestopping are implemented.

Fire Room Purpose and Considerations

A fire-rated electrical room is designed either to contain fires and prevent their spread or to protect equipment from external fires, typically for one to two hours using fire-resistant walls, ceilings, and doors . Electrical rooms inherently carry fire risks due to equipment like transformers, panelboards, and distribution boards, which can overheat, spark, or fail . Therefore, careful planning is required when installing a distribution box in such a space.

Clearance and Safety Requirements

Electrical distribution equipment should not be surrounded by combustible materials. Small enclosures must be used solely for electrical equipment, and larger cupboards should maintain a minimum clearance of 500 mm, with 1 meter preferred for fire safety . Circuit protection devices like RCDs can help prevent fires caused by small earth leakage currents .
