

Can iron pipes be connected to cable trays



Overview

With the NEC, there's a specific rule: 300. 8 Installation of Conductors with Other Systems. Race- ways or cable trays containing electrical conductors shall not contain any pipe, tube, or equal for steam, water, air, gas, drain- age, or any service other than electrical. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. Question 1: Can mechanical utility piping or tubing containing water or compressed air be installed in cable trays with electrical cables?

Answer: No. Cable trays are a support system for electrical cables, power, signal, and communication and optical fiber cables. NEC section 300-8 does not permit. Assuming you're talking about hung cable tray (not cable tray on the floor.) putting wet utilities underneath makes them a lot easier to access and maintain.
