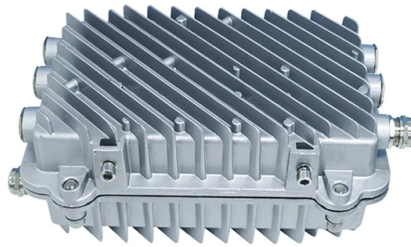


Commonly Used Cables in Low-Voltage Distribution Boxes

For low-voltage distribution boxes, use cables rated up to 1 kV with copper or aluminum conductors, appropriate insulation (PVC, XLPE, or LSZH), and armoring if mechanical protection is required.

Key Considerations

Voltage Rating: Low-voltage cables typically operate at 50 V to 1 kV, with most distribution boxes using 230/400 V systems in Europe or 600 V-rated cables in the U.S. Ensure the cable is rated for the system voltage to prevent insulation breakdown and safety hazards . **Conductor Material:** Copper is preferred for its high conductivity and flexibility, while aluminum may be used for cost-sensitive or larger feeder cables . **Insulation Type:** Common insulation materials include:

- PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride): Standard for indoor installations, resistant to moisture and chemicals.
 - XLPE (Cross-Linked Polyethylene): Higher temperature tolerance (up to 90°C), suitable for wet or dry conditions.
 - LSZH (Low-Smoke, Zero-Halogen): Ideal for densely populated or enclosed areas to reduce toxic fumes during fire .
- Armoring:** Armored cables (e.g., SWA – Steel Wire Armored) are recommended for incoming mains or areas where mechanical damage is possible, such as cable trays, floor ducts, or outdoor installations .
