- **Signal Integrity Protection:** Proper bend radius control, strain relief, and EMI/RFI shielding prevent signal loss and physical damage to delicate fibers .
- **Modular Design:** Supports incremental expansion, mixed connector types (LC, SC, MTP), and easy component replacement without system downtime . These boxes are widely used in Main Distribution Areas (MDA) and Horizontal Distribution Areas (HDA) to aggregate backbone connections, provide cross-connect capabilities, and enable rapid reconfiguration during network upgrades .
