Electrical distribution boxes vary widely in size, from compact wall-mounted units around 200 × 200 × 120 mm to large freestanding cabinets exceeding 2200 mm in height, with dimensions chosen based on application, number of circuits, and internal layout.

Standard Size Ranges

Wall-Mount Enclosures: Typically range from 200 × 200 × 120 mm up to 800 × 600 × 300 mm, suitable for residential, small commercial, or light industrial applications where space is limited and fewer circuits are required . Freestanding Cabinets: Commonly range from 1600–2200 mm in height, 600–1800 mm in width, and 300–600 mm in depth, designed for industrial control, power distribution, or large-scale automation systems . Compact Plastic or FRP Boxes: Hand-sized units around 100–300 mm are used for low-power gear, sensor hubs, or branch circuit junctions, often with IP55–IP66 protection for outdoor or washdown environments . Breaker Panels and Junction Boxes: Standard residential and commercial panels typically accommodate 12 to 42 circuits, with double meter panels available for multi-unit installations . Industrial 3-phase junction boxes may be larger to house busbars, isolators, and protective devices .

- Number and Type of Components: More devices or larger components like MCBs, RCBOs, busbars, and surge protection devices require larger enclosures
