Overview

Front clearance: There should be a minimum of 3 feet of clearance at the front of all electrical equipment, including panelboards, switches, breakers, starters, transformers, etc. Note that all panel doors and access doors must be able to open a minimum of 90 degrees. The International Standards of Practice for Inspecting Commercial Properties (ComSOP) states that the inspector should report on the lack of accessibility or working space for electrical panels and gear that would hamper their safe operation, maintenance, and inspection.
