Purpose of Labeling

Labeling distribution box accessories is essential to:

- Enhance safety by clearly identifying high-voltage components and potential hazards ().
- Facilitate maintenance and troubleshooting by providing clear circuit and equipment identification ().
- Ensure regulatory compliance with standards such as NFPA 70, ANSI Z535.4, and local electrical codes ().

Key Labeling Elements

- Circuit Identification: Each circuit should have a unique number or code that corresponds to a panelboard directory or schematic ().
- Equipment Nameplates: Use durable materials like Lamicoid or engraved plastic with clear lettering. Include voltage, current rating, and manufacturer information ().
- Color Coding: Apply standardized colors to wiring, conduits, and accessories to indicate function or hazard level. For example, red may indicate high voltage, yellow for caution, and green for grounding ().
- Panelboard Directories: Maintain a directory inside the distribution box showing each breaker or fuse and the area or equipment it serves ().
- Safety Signage: Include warning labels such as "DANGER—HIGH VOLTAGE—KEEP..."
