## Article Overview

Distribution and low-voltage boxes must maintain proper clearance and isolation even when obstructed, following IEC, NEC, and OSHA standards to ensure safety and maintainability.

### Clearance Requirements

Electrical panels and distribution boxes require adequate space around them to allow safe operation and maintenance. According to OSHA and the National Electrical Code (NEC), the minimum clearance around electrical panels is 36 inches in depth, 30 inches in width, and 78 inches in height to prevent hazards such as electric shock, fire, or equipment damage, even if the sides are partially obstructed. Maintaining these clearances ensures that technicians can safely access terminals, breakers, and wiring.

### Isolation and Zoning

When high-voltage and low-voltage systems share a box, physical isolation is critical. Use flame-retardant ABS isolation plates to separate high-voltage ( $\geq 380V$ ) and low-voltage ( $\leq 24V$ ) areas, keeping a minimum distance of 5 cm from terminals to reduce electromagnetic interference. High-voltage wires should be routed along the box edges, while low-voltage wires pass through central slots, optionally with metal shielding tubes for additional protection....
