

# Distribution box wiring bends



## Article Overview

Proper wiring bends in a distribution box require consistent, smooth curves with adequate bending space to prevent conductor damage and ensure code compliance.

### Conductor Bending Guidelines

When wiring a distribution box, all conductor bends should be smooth and consistent, avoiding sharp or “dead” bends that can damage insulation or the internal copper core . Conductors should be routed straight where possible, with bends made gradually to maintain the integrity of the wire. Plastic ties can be used to secure wires, spaced uniformly (typically every 100mm), and any excess wire should be trimmed after tying .

### Minimum Wire-Bending Space

The National Electrical Code (NEC) Table 312.6 specifies minimum wire-bending space at terminals. For example, a 1 AWG aluminum conductor requires about 2 inches of bending space, while larger conductors like 3/0 AWG may require 4–5 inches, depending on whether the conductor enters or leaves the enclosure opposite its terminal . The manufacturer of the distribution box typically provides adequate gutter space for the largest conductor the lugs can accept.

### Wiring Practices

- Phase and Neutral Wiring: Each phase (A, B, C) should be clearly color-coded (e.g., yellow, green, red), and neutral lines should not be shared between circuits ....
