Not all switches have optical ports; switches can have purely Ethernet ports, purely optical ports, or a combination of both.

Types of Switch Ports

Switches are generally categorized based on the type of ports they provide:

- **Ethernet-only switches:** These switches have only copper RJ45 ports and use standard Ethernet cables for data transmission. They are common in access-layer networks and support speeds typically up to 10G depending on the cable type and switch model .
- **Optical-only switches (all-optical switches):** These switches provide only fiber-optic ports, supporting high-speed data transmission over long distances without converting optical signals to electrical signals. They are often used in core or aggregation layers of data centers and high-performance networks .
- **Hybrid switches:** These switches include both Ethernet and optical ports, allowing flexible connectivity for both copper and fiber networks. Some optical ports can also accept modules that convert them to Ethernet connections if needed .

Key Differences Between Optical and Ethernet Ports

- **Transmission speed:** Optical ports can support very high speeds, such as 10G, 25G, 40G, 100G, and beyond, while Ethernet ports typically max out at 10G for standard...
