Busbars are electrically conductive strips or bars that carry current from the incoming supply to multiple outgoing circuits within a low-voltage switchgear panel . They act as the main conductor rails, ensuring efficient power distribution while minimizing voltage drops and improving thermal performance . Typical low-voltage switchgear panels include several busbar types: main busbar, sub-busbar, neutral busbar, and earthing busbar, each serving distinct electrical and protective functions .

Design and Standards

Busbars in low-voltage switchgear are designed according to IEC 61439, which specifies requirements for current rating, short-circuit withstand, temperature rise, insulation, and environmental conditions . Proper sizing and material selection (usually copper or aluminum) are critical to ensure safe operation, prevent overheating, and maintain reliability under fault conditions . Busbars can be arranged horizontally or vertically within compartments, affecting heat flow, cable landing, and future expansion .
