A standard distribution box does not have built-in sockets; it distributes power to circuits, which can then be connected to sockets via branch wiring.

Understanding the Distribution Box

A distribution box (DB), also called a distribution board or consumer unit, is an enclosure that receives incoming electrical power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective devices like MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs . Its main functions include:

- **Distribution:** Splits incoming power into separate circuits.
- **Protection:** Disconnects faulty circuits using breakers or fuses.
- **Connection:** Organizes live, neutral, and earth conductors.
- **Containment:** Protects users from live parts and shields components from dust, moisture, and impact . The box itself does not contain sockets; instead, it provides power to circuits that can be wired to sockets, lights, or appliances.

Connecting Sockets to a Distribution Box

To connect sockets, follow these general steps:

- **Identify the circuit:** Decide which MCB or breaker will supply the socket. For home lighting and socket circuits, 2.5mm² wires are commonly used .
- **Wire from the DB:** Connect the phase (live) wire from the output of the chosen MC...
