A coupler with a pigtail is a connector assembly where one end has a coupler interface and the other end has a short, pre-terminated wire (pigtail) for easy integration into a system.

What It Is

A pigtail is a short length of wire with a connector pre-installed on one end and bare or exposed conductors on the other. When combined with a coupler, the assembly allows a device or cable to connect to a larger system without directly terminating the main cable. The coupler end typically plugs into a socket, outlet, or another connector, while the pigtail end is spliced, crimped, or soldered into the existing wiring harness or circuit .

How It Works

The pigtail acts as a bridge between the coupler and the main wiring. This design simplifies installation in tight spaces, reduces mechanical stress on the main cable, and maintains signal or power integrity. For example, in fiber optics, a pigtail with a coupler allows a single fiber to be fusion-spliced to a multi-fiber trunk, while in automotive or electrical systems, it enables secure connections to sensors, switches, or outlets .
