

Drilling dimensions for the main electrical distribution box

Drilling dimensions for main electrical distribution boxes depend on the box type, capacity, and mounting requirements, with standard industrial boxes providing pre-marked holes for busbars, MCCBs, and cable glands.

Standard Box Sizes and Layout

For industrial and commercial main distribution boxes, dimensions vary based on capacity (e.g., 63, 100, 160, 315 KVA) and the number of devices. Typical considerations include:

- **Box Material:** Usually 2 mm GI sheet steel for outdoor boxes, reinforced with channels for rigidity .
- **Door and Hinges:** Doors often have concealed hinges and overlap by 10 mm with rubber gaskets for sealing .
- **Protection Rating:** IP-33 to IP-55 depending on outdoor or indoor installation .
- **Internal Volume:** Must accommodate busbars, MCCBs, and wiring without overcrowding. Depth is critical; common depths range from 1.5" to 3.5" for smaller boxes, while industrial boxes are deeper to allow multiple conductors .

Drilling and Mounting Considerations

- **Busbar Mounting:** Phase busbars are typically drilled and mounted with adequate clearance from the box body. For example, 72×50×8 mm busbars for 63/100 KVA a...
