Dual-core outdoor single-mode fiber cables use two single-mode fibers in a single cable, optimized for long-distance, high-speed outdoor transmission with robust environmental protection.

Overview

A dual-core single-mode fiber contains two optical fibers within a single cable, each capable of transmitting light in a single mode. This design effectively doubles the data transmission capacity compared to a single-core fiber while maintaining the advantages of single-mode transmission, such as low signal loss and minimal dispersion, making it ideal for long-distance outdoor applications ().

Fiber Type and Performance

- Single-mode fibers (SMF) have a small core diameter of approximately $9\text{ }\mu\text{m}$, allowing only one light path, which reduces modal dispersion and supports high-speed, long-distance transmission ().
- OS2 standard is commonly used for outdoor dual-core fibers, featuring a loose-tube, gel-filled or dry design to protect against moisture and environmental stress ().
- Typical wavelengths for single-mode outdoor fibers are 1310 nm and 1550 nm, supporting distances from several kilometers up to 200 km depending on network design ().
