

Dual-mode transceivers for single-mode fiber optic cables



Article Overview

Single-mode transceivers require single-mode fiber, and using dual-mode (or multimode) fiber can cause signal loss and reduced performance unless mode-conditioning or specialized modules are used.

Fiber and Transceiver Compatibility

Single-mode fiber (SMF) has a core diameter of about 9 microns and is optimized for long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission at wavelengths of 1310 nm or 1550 nm . Multimode fiber (MMF) has a larger core (50–62.5 microns) and is designed for shorter distances with multiple light modes . Dual-mode fiber, sometimes referred to as OM3/OM4/OM5, can support both single-mode and multimode signals over short distances, but single-mode transceivers are designed for SMF, and connecting them directly to multimode cores can lead to modal dispersion, higher attenuation, and reduced link distance .

Transceiver Types

- Dual-fiber transceivers use two fibers: one for transmit (TX) and one for receive (RX). They are standard for single-mode links and provide stable, long-distance communication .
- Single-fiber BiDi transceivers use wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM) to transmit and receive over a single fiber, often in the 1310/1490 nm or 1310/1550 nm range . BiDi modules are ideal when fiber resources are limited...
