Fiber optic Ethernet switches are network devices that use fiber connections to transmit data, either exclusively (all-optical switches) or alongside copper ports (hybrid switches). Unlike traditional copper-based switches, fiber switches avoid electro-optical conversions, reducing latency, power consumption, and points of failure. They are suitable for high-performance environments such as data centers, enterprise backbones, high-performance computing clusters, and fiber campus networks. Fiber switches come in managed and unmanaged formats, supporting speeds from 10 Mbps to 100 Gbps and beyond, with options for PoE to power connected devices. They can accommodate singlemode or multimode fiber, often using SFP modules for flexible port configurations.

Deployment and Network Topologies

Fiber switches can be deployed at different layers of a network:

- Core Layer: Aggregates high-speed traffic from multiple distribution switches.
- Distribution/Aggregation Layer: Connects access switches and manages traffic efficiently.
- Access Layer: Directly connects servers or endpoints equipped with fiber NICs in s...
