

Fabrication of double-layer cable tray elbows



Article Overview

Double-layer cable tray elbows are fabricated by bending and joining high-quality metal trays to allow multi-tier cable routing while maintaining structural integrity and compliance with standards.

Materials and Selection

Double-layer elbows are typically fabricated from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements. Steel trays may be pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized to resist corrosion, while stainless steel (AISI 316L) provides superior resistance in harsh or chemical environments. Aluminum is lightweight and corrosion-resistant due to its natural oxide layer, making it suitable for indoor or mildly corrosive conditions .

Tools and Equipment

Fabrication requires:

- Sheet metal shears or plasma cutters for cutting tray sections.
- Press brakes or bending machines to form precise elbow angles.
- Welding equipment (MIG/TIG) for joining layers and reinforcing structural integrity.
- Drills and fasteners for assembling multi-layer trays and securing rungs or side rails
