

Fiber Optic Cable Clipping

Fiber optic cable clipping involves carefully cutting, stripping, and preparing the fiber to ensure clean, precise ends for splicing or connectorization.

Tools Required

Proper fiber optic cable preparation requires specialized tools to avoid damaging the delicate glass fibers:

- **Fiber Optic Strippers:** Remove the outer jacket and buffer coatings without harming the core fiber. Tools like the FOS03 or Thorlabs TSK1 kit provide matched blades and fiber guides for precise stripping .
- **Cable Cutters and Kevlar Scissors:** Used to cut the outer sheath and Kevlar strength members cleanly .
- **Fiber Optic Cleaver:** Produces a flat, perpendicular cleave essential for low-loss splicing .
- **Utility Knife or Razor Blade:** Can score the jacket for careful removal, but requires steady hands and experience .
- **Bare Fiber Gripper:** Holds the fiber securely during stripping to prevent microfractures .

Step-by-Step Clipping Process

- **Remove the Outer Jacket:** Use a fiber jacket stripper or utility knife to carefully cut and peel off the outer sheath, exposing the Kevlar fibers and coated glass strands .
- **Handle Kevlar Strength Members:** Twist Kevlar fibers into a rope-like strand and cut with metal scissors to prevent fraying
