Material and Design

Riser pipes are typically made from lightweight, UV-stabilized PVC, which resists rust, corrosion, and denting. The interior surface is smooth to prevent cable snags, and they come in straight, offset, and elbowed configurations to accommodate different routing needs. Some risers feature split designs that allow pre-connectorized fiber drops to be inserted without forcing bulky connectors through the pipe.
