SFP Transceiver Modules

To connect multimode fiber to a switch, you generally need an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) transceiver module compatible with multimode fiber. These modules handle the conversion between electrical signals in the switch and optical signals in the fiber. Most modern fiber-enabled switches support duplex multimode connections (two strands: one for transmit, one for receive) using LC connectors . Common multimode SFP types include OM3, OM4, and OM5, which differ in bandwidth and reach.
