A Fiber Channel switch module is a hardware component that expands or upgrades the port capacity of an FC switch, enabling high-speed connectivity in storage area networks (SANs).

Overview of FC Switch Modules

A Fiber Channel (FC) switch module is designed to provide additional ports or higher-speed connectivity to an existing FC switch, allowing SAN administrators to scale their storage networks efficiently. These modules are typically hot-swappable, meaning they can be installed without powering down the switch, and they support various speeds such as 8 Gbps, 16 Gbps, and 32 Gbps depending on the switch model and module type .

Functionality

FC switch modules serve several key purposes:

- **Port Expansion:** They increase the number of available ports on a switch, allowing more servers or storage devices to connect to the SAN .
- **Speed Upgrade:** Some modules provide higher-speed ports, enabling future-proofing of the network without replacing the entire switch .
- **Flexibility:** Modules can be configured in switch mode or Network Port Virtualization (NPV) mode, depending on the SAN architecture .
- **Compatibility:** FC modules are compatible with standard SFP/SFP+ transceivers, which support different distances and fiber types, including single-mode and multi-...
