Overview

A fiber tail sleeve is a protective assembly used in fiber optic networks to manage the bare fiber end (tail) after splicing. It typically consists of a support tube made of hard material and elastic protection tubes at both ends, which provide mechanical support and protection against bending or stress. The sleeve ensures that the fiber tail is properly aligned, protected from environmental factors, and organized for future maintenance.

Structure and Components

- **Support Tube:** Central hard material tube that provides structural support and maintains alignment of the fiber tail.
- **Protection Tubes:** Elastic tubes at each end of the support tube that absorb stress and protect the fiber from mechanical damage.
- **Sealing Ferrule (Optional):** In some designs, a ferrule is inserted into the sleeve and hermetically sealed to prevent stress and maintain optical performance.

Method and Procedure

- **Splicing:** The bare fiber tail is first spliced to the incoming fiber using either fusion splicing or mechanical splicing. Fusion splicing provides lower loss, while mechanical...
