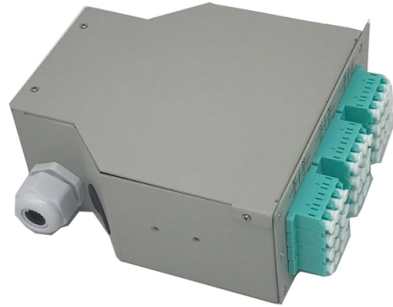


Fiber optic cable occupies exterior wall
