Fiber optic cables can be safely installed in cable trays, provided they meet NEC listing requirements and are designed to withstand mechanical and environmental stresses.

NEC Compliance and Cable Tray Use

According to the 2023 National Electric Code (NEC), any listed optical fiber cable is acceptable for installation in a cable tray, even though there is no specific "tray rating" for fiber optic cables as there is for power cables . Cable trays are considered open support systems, unlike fully enclosed raceways, and are classified as being exposed to potential mechanical damage. NEC Article 392 outlines the requirements for cable tray installations, and NEC Article 770 specifies the types of optical fiber cables allowed in trays, including conductive and non-conductive fiber optic cables .

Types of Fiber Optic Tray Cables

Fiber Optic Tray Cables (FOTC) are specifically designed for tray installations. These cables are typically tight-buffered, providing easier terminations and enhanced mechanical durability. They are engineered to withstand:

- Aggressive pulling during installation
- Impact from falling debris
- Harsh temperature ranges, both hot and cold
- UV exposure for outdoor applications FOTC cables are available in various jacket types, such as "J" jackets for cold environments (-50°C to +75°C) and "D" jackets f...
