

# Fiber optic connector 1-to-2 connection method

- Select a compatible splitter or coupler: Choose a device that matches the connector type of your fiber cables (e.g., SC-to-SC or LC-to-LC). Splitters can be passive (1x2) or PLC (planar lightwave circuit), depending on your application.
- Prepare the fiber ends: Strip the outer jacket, clean the fiber with alcohol and lint-free wipes, and inspect for damage .
- Connect the input fiber: Insert the single fiber into the input port of the splitter or coupler, ensuring the ferrule is fully seated and aligned.
- Connect the output fibers: Insert the two output fibers into the output ports of the...
