They are also categorized by connector types, such as SC, LC, FC, ST, MPO, and others, which determine compatibility with different network equipment. In essence, a fiber optic patch cord is a pre-terminated fiber optic cable designed for quick and reliable interconnection in fiber optic networks. Its construction ensures low signal attenuation, high durability, and flexibility for use in data centers, telecommunications, industrial automation, and other high-speed network environments.
