

Fiber optic splice box connected to switch

The fiber optic splice box for a switch is typically located either integrated with the switch in a rack or wall-mounted nearby, containing splice trays where fiber cables are terminated and connected to the switch ports.

Typical Placement

Fiber optic splice boxes, also called splice distributors, are housings where fiber optic cables begin or end. They are often positioned at the end of fiber transmission paths and can be wall-mounted, rack-mounted, or integrated directly with a managed Ethernet switch . In some smart city or industrial setups, the splice box and switch are combined into a single enclosure, providing both fiber splicing and Ethernet connectivity in one unit .

Structure and Access

Inside the splice box, splice trays hold the fibers, allowing them to be fused or mechanically spliced. The front panel contains connectors that link the fibers to the switch or other network devices . Modern splice boxes may include removable cassettes, making it easier to assemble fibers and connect them to the switch ports . Cable entries are usually at the top or bottom of the box, and the enclosure may have lockable covers for security .
