

# Fiberglass tray installation



## Article Overview

Proper installation of fiberglass cable trays requires careful planning, correct support spacing, secure mounting, and post-installation checks to ensure safety and long-term performance.

### Pre-Installation Preparation

Before starting, review construction drawings and conduct an on-site inspection to determine tray routes, installation height, support spacing, and any bends or junctions required . Check all materials, including trays, supports, connectors, and fasteners, for quality and integrity, ensuring there are no cracks, broken edges, or fiber delamination . Protect trays during transport from heavy impacts, drops, or prolonged sun exposure to maintain structural integrity .

### Support and Mounting

Fiberglass trays require closer support spacing than steel trays due to their lower elastic modulus. Typical spacing for a 300mm-wide FRP ladder tray carrying 75 kg/m of cables is 1.8–2.4 meters, compared to 3–3.6 meters for steel . Supports can be wall-mounted, column-mounted, or suspended, and adjustable hangers are recommended for ceiling installations to accommodate different heights and angles . Use a spirit level to ensure trays are level and aligned along the entire run .
