

Ground wire of finished distribution box



Article Overview

The ground wire of a finished distribution box connects the metal enclosure, internal components, and PE bus to the main grounding system to ensure safety and proper operation.

Key Grounding Points

- **PE Bus or Grounding Bar:** Inside the distribution box, locate the PE (Protective Earth) bus or grounding bar. This is the central point where all ground wires converge and connect to the main power ground wire for the system .
- **Metal Enclosure:** The metal casing of the distribution box must be grounded. Use a copper core wire or braided soft wire to connect the box to the PE bus via a dedicated grounding bolt marked with "PE" .
- **Electrical Components:** Any internal components that require grounding should be connected to the PE bus using copper wires. This ensures that all conductive parts are safely referenced to ground .
- **External Grounding:** The PE bus is connected to the main grounding system, which may include a ground rod or factory central grounding point. Ground rods should be buried and tested for resistance to ensure compliance with safety standards, typically below 25 ohms .

Wire Specifications

- **Wire Type:** Use yellow-green insulated copper core wire for visibility and safety .
- **Cross-Section:** Minimum cross-sectional area depends on local standards: 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) in the US, 6 mm² elsewhere. For connections between mounting plates and spindles, larger wires (16 mm² or 6 AWG) may be required to maintain low resistanc...
