What are the risks of not following height. In homes, the best height for installation is about 1. In industrial settings, you may need to adjust the height depending on the space and equipment around it. Leave enough space around the box for air to flow and for future. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. Site selection requirements: The distribution box should be. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1.
