- Bolted connections use standard fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and washers to hold splice plates or other fittings in place. These connections are reliable, allow for future disassembly, and are suitable for long straight runs or heavy cable loads .

2. Quick-Connect Systems

- These are manufacturer-specific systems that snap, slide, or twist together, requiring few or no tools. They allow rapid installation and are ideal for large projects where speed is critical. However, they may be less flexible if using trays from different brands .
