Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

NEC Code of Junction Box Requirements Made Simple

If the box opening is less than 8 inches, wires must extend at least 3 inches outside the opening. Wires that do not get spliced or connected do not need to follow this rule.
