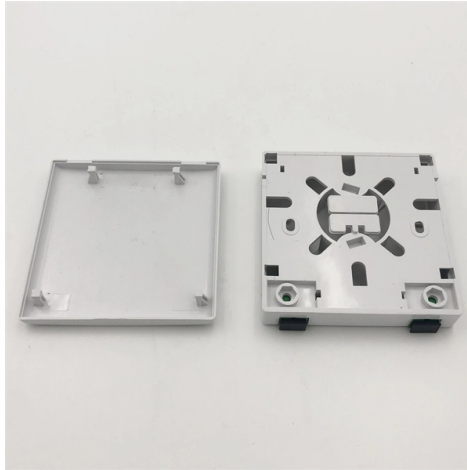


# How many cores are in the secondary distribution box



## Article Overview

A typical secondary distribution box contains 4 cores, corresponding to a 3-phase, 4-wire system.

### Explanation

Secondary distribution boxes (SDBs) are used to distribute low-voltage power from the main distribution board (MDB) to individual floors, sections, or equipment within a building. They are part of the low-voltage network, typically operating at 400/230 V in a three-phase system.

### Core Configuration

- Three-phase conductors (L1, L2, L3): These carry the three alternating current phases.
- Neutral conductor (N): Provides a return path for single-phase loads and balances the system. This configuration results in 4 cores inside the secondary distribution box. Single-phase loads, such as lighting or standard outlets, are connected between any one phase and the neutral, while three-phase loads, like motors, are connected across all three phases directly.

- Some SDBs may include a protective earth (PE) conductor, which is often separat...
