

How many levels does an FTTR splitter support



Overview

While the two-level approach is common, more than two splitting levels, referred to as multi-level splitting, are possible in a cascaded system, with a variable overall split ratio such as $1 \times 16 = 4 \times 4$, $1 \times 32 = 4 \times 8$, or $1 \times 64 = 4 \times 4 \times 4$. A key challenge is determining how many users a single OLT port can support, which is defined by the split ratio. Traditional GPON networks often employ 1:32 or 1:64 splits, while XGS-PON allows higher ratios such as 1:128. However, higher splits reduce the power margin and limit reach, so. The two main types are PLC (Planar Lightwave Circuit) splitters and FBT (Fused Biconical Taper) splitters. PLC splitters: higher precision, good for large ratios (e., 1×32 , 1×64 and beyond), uniform output, stable across temperature variations. 1 x Main FTTR can supports maximum 16 Sub FTTR.
