- **Single Fiber Cables:** Contain one optical fiber, typically used for point-to-point links where only one communication channel is needed .
- **Duplex Cables:** Contain two fibers, allowing full-duplex communication for simultaneous sending and receiving of data .
- **Multifiber Cables:** Can contain multiple fibers, ranging from a few pairs to several hundred fibers, commonly used in data centers or long-haul networks . A fiber pair usually consists of two fibers for bidirectional communication. Cables generally have 1-288 strands, with even numbers being most common . High-density cables can support hundreds of fibers in a single sheath.

Factors Affecting Fiber Connections

- **Network Requirements:** The number of devices, bandwidth needs, and redundancy requirements determine how many fibers are needed .
- **Full-Duplex Links:** Typically, two fibers are required per link (one for transmit, one...
