

How many meters is a horizontal cable tray support

For horizontal sections where cable trays are laid out in a straight line, the typical support span (distance between supports) should range from 1. This range allows for easy access and efficient maintenance. It also helps reduce the risk of. The supports are not placed at the ends of each tray sections, but instead are located at a distance no greater than 1/4 of the length of the tray (e.g. 1.5 meters for a 6 meter tray).
