Fiber optic patch cords typically contain 1 (simplex), 2 (duplex), or multiple fibers (4, 6, 12) depending on the application.

Fiber optic patch cords, also called fiber jumpers, are short cables used to connect optical devices such as switches, transceivers, routers, and patch panels . The number of fibers in a patch cord depends on the type of connection required: Simplex (1 fiber): Contains a single optical fiber and is used for one-way data transmission . Duplex (2 fibers): The most common configuration, with two fibers for bidirectional communication, often used in data centers and enterprise networks . Multi-fiber (4, 6, 12 fibers or more): Used in high-density applications, such as MPO/MTP patch cords for 40G, 100G, or 400G parallel optics, allowing multiple channels in a single cable . The choice of fiber count also depends on the network type (single-mode or multimode), distance, and bandwidth requirements. Duplex cords are standard for most intra-rack or inter-rack connections, while multi-fiber cords are preferred for high-speed, high-density data center environments.
