

How thick are the fireproof partitions for cable trays



Article Overview

The standard thickness of a fireproof partition for cable trays is generally 10 millimeters or greater.

Thickness and Fire Resistance

Installation Requirements

- Positioning: The partition should be installed at least 100 millimeters away from the edge of the tray to effectively block fire propagation .
- Width: The partition width should be equal to or greater than the width of the cable tray to ensure complete coverage .
- Fixing: Partitions must be securely fastened to the tray using appropriate fasteners to maintain stability and reliability .
- Observation Holes: Small observation holes can be included to monitor the internal condition of the tray without compromising fire protection .
