

How to Choose Home Broadband Fiber Optic Cables

Selecting the right fiber optic cable for your home depends on fiber type, connector type, installation environment, and future network needs.

Fiber Type: Single-Mode vs. Multimode

- Single-Mode Fiber (OS2): Yellow sheath, smaller core, supports long-distance transmission (several kilometers), ideal for FTTH (Fiber to the Home) and future-proofing your network . It is the mainstream choice for home installations and ensures compatibility with most broadband providers .
- Multimode Fiber (OM3/OM4): Cyan or violet sheath, larger core, suitable for short-distance connections (typically under a few hundred meters), cost-effective for home LANs or 10 Gigabit intranet setups . OM4 can support distances up to 550 meters at 1 Gbps .

Connector Types

- SC Connector: Square head, commonly used for optical modem interfaces in homes . One end of the cable connecting to the wall socket is usually SC.
- LC Connector: Smaller square connector, often used in enterprise-grade switches or SFP modules, suitable for high-end 10 Gigabit LANs .
- APC vs. UPC: APC (green) connectors have a beveled end for low return loss and are standard in most home fiber installations
